Central Coast and Newcastle Cat Club

All shows run by the Central Coast and Newcastle Cat Club are Australian Open Style where the judges officiate in front of exhibitors and spectators and speaks with the audience about the cats being judged.

Exhibits are divided into four Groups for judging:

Group 1 - Longhair - includes: Birman, Exotic, Maine Coon, Norwegian Forest Cat, Persian, Siberian, Ragdolls & Turkish Van;

Group 2 - Balinese, Oriental, Oriental Longhair, Siamese;

Group 3 - Abyssinian, Australian Mist, Bengal, Bombay, British Shorthair, Burmese, Burmilla, Burmilla Shorthair, Burmilla Longhair, Chartreux, Cornish Rex, Cymric, Devon Rex, Egyptian Mau, European Shorthair, German Rex, Japanese Bobtail, Korat, Munchkin, Ocicat, Russian, Scottish Fold, Scottish Fold Longhair, Scottish Shorthair, Singapura, Somali, Tonkinese, Selkirk Rex, Sphynx,;

Group 4 - Domestic/Companion Animals (cats not holding certified pedigree registration)

Group 1, 2, 3, is divided into three main classes: Entire Cat, Desexed Cat, and Kitten. Group 4, two main classes, Desexed Cat & Kittens (please note that all kittens over the age of 4 months of age must be desexed.

AWARDS

Challenges: All females, males, neuters & spays will compete in open classes by breed & colour.

ACF Awards: (where merited) will be awarded in all rings to the best placed exhibit Male, Female, Neuter, Spay in Groups 1, 2, & 3. The exhibit must be placed in the Top 5 to be considered for this award.

Where the judges feel the quality of the exhibits merit such awards, ribbons and/or product will be awarded in each ring to the Top 5 Entire Cats, Top 5 Desexed Cats, Top 5 Kittens in Groups 1, 2, & 3. Top 5 Companion Cats & Top 5 Companion Kittens will be awarded in Group 4.

Supreme Exhibit in Show will be awarded in All breeds rings only (Groups 1, 2, & 3).

Best Exhibit in Show will be awarded by each judge in split rings.

Supreme Companion will be awarded.

All exhibits are eligible to compete for The Feline Association of NSW Cat of The Year points.

BENCHING AND VETTING

8.00am to 9.00am with judging to commence at 9.30am. Any cat not in its cage at the commencement of judging in each ring will be disqualified from judging in that ring.

CCNCC. representatives & officiating judges reserve the right without prejudice, to expel any exhibit from the show that appears to be in ill health or condition (including the presence of external parasites). Such decisions are final.

*Please note that Breeders Choice must be used at this show to protest the hall flooring. This show is proudly sponsored by **Fibre Cycle**. Breeders Choice litter will be provided to all exhibitors. Please ensure you bring a litter tray*

Rules and Regulations

SHOW RULES

These rules govern all shows held by The Feline Association of NSW Inc. of its affiliate clubs. All shows are conducted under the rules of The Feline Association of NSW Inc. and the show committee reserves the right to reject any entry without explanation. All reasonable care will be taken of exhibits, but The Feline Association of NSW Inc. its affiliate clubs, or their officials, accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any feline or exhibitor's property at the show.

1. All pedigree exhibits hold registration recognised by TFA of NSW Inc.
2. Exhibits will be judged under the standard of points of the Australian Cat Federation.
3. No exhibits, including those on exhibition only, suffering from infectious or contagious disease will be allowed to enter upon or remain in the hall, neither shall any exhibit from a cattery that has been infected with Feline Enteritis within the preceding period of 3 months or any other infectious disease within the previous 30 days of show.
4. In cage vetting: A Vet will be present on the day to inspect all exhibits. HE/she will be empowered to disqualify all exhibits, which in their opinion are suffering from any infectious or contagious disease or are not in show condition.
5. If a Vet is not present or has left the hall, then a Vetting-In committee comprising of at least 2 CCNCC members will be appointed to check exhibits on the day and request the removal of any exhibit they feel is not in show condition.
6. Cats obviously in kitten will not be judged. No kitten under the age of 12 weeks will be allowed entry to the venue. Lactating Queens shall not be benched without their litter.
7. ALL EXHIBITS MUST HAVE ALL THEIR CLAWS CLIPPED PRIOR TO THE SHOW

8. A judge is empowered to withhold any award in any class if in his/her opinion the exhibit does not possess sufficient merit. Any protests can be made to the show committee, in writing, accompanied by a \$20 fee within 7 days after the show. A judge may not judge an exhibit that has been domiciled at their home during the preceding 3 months.
9. An open Challenge system is used. All entire/altere cats will compete in their own colours within their own breed. Challenges can be used in any status section.
10. All Companion Pets over the age of 6 months must be desexed.
11. NO EXHIBIT MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE HALL PRIOR TO THE CONCLUSION OF THE SHOW WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF THE SHOW MANAGER OR MEMBER OF THE SHOW COMMITTEE.
12. DIFFICULT TO HANDLE CATS: If at any time an exhibit shows itself to be difficult to handle or threatening, the Judge may call for the owner to remove the exhibit from its cage and place it on the Judge's table. The Judge will then decide if she/he wishes to judge the animal. This procedure protects your cat from any unnecessary handling. Should the exhibit be marked "Unable to be judged" then it is automatically withdrawn from any other rings and cannot be shown again that day. Should the judge consider the exhibit TO BE OF POOR TEMPERAMENT or in their opinion sufficiently difficult to handle, including excessively timid, the judge may withhold any award at their discretion.
13. Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated. The comfort of all exhibitors and judges is of paramount importance. One warning will be issued and if any further offences occur the exhibitor and their exhibits will be asked to leave the show.
14. An entrance fee is payable by all members of the public i.e. not an exhibitor or invited guest of Central Coast and Newcastle Cat Club. Exception is Agricultural Shows. If a member of the general public is deemed to be acting in a disruptive manner that individual will be required by the Show Representative to leave the show immediately. CCNCC reserves the right to refuse entry to any member of the public they feel may cause discomfort to their exhibitors.
